In the Primary School our students are busy learning English in all its forms, including working with words and sentence structure. For example, Year 1 is looking at questions, and how they are different from other sentences. Year 2 is constructing their own sentences using punctuation to show surprise. Year 3 is using antonyms and connectors of purpose to expand their writing skills. Year 4 is making their writing more interesting with adjectives while Years 5 and 6 are expanding their English skills through complex literature and spellings.

As always our KIK are developing their life skills and increasing their knowledge of numbers and vocabulary with rhymes, songs, role play and stories.
